LK Manifold Cabinet UFH, LK Manifold Cabinet UFH Prefab LK Shunt Cabinet VS2, Shunt Cabinet VS2 Prefab

Scope

These assembly instructions are intended to be used for LK Manifold Cabinet UFH, LK Shunt Cabinet VS2 and for its versions in Prefab design. Installation must be carried out in accordance with industry regulations Safe Water Installation.

LK Manifold Cabinet UFH

LK Manifold Cabinet UFH is used when LK Manifold RF is to be hidden. The manifold cabinet is available in widths of 550, 800 and 1050 mm. In the Prefab version, the cabinet is delivered with a pre-assembled distributor.

LK Shunt Cabinet VS2

LK Shunt Cabinet VS2 is used when LK Manifold Shunt VS2 and LK Manifold RF are to be hidden. The shunt cabinet is available in widths of 800 and 1050 mm. In the Prefab version, the cabinet is delivered with a pre-assembled shunt and distributor.

LK Frame/Hatch UFH INB

Used for LK Manifold Cabinet UFH and LK Shunt Cabinet UFH as these cabinets are built into the wall. Frame/door has a drop-out frame to cover the hole punching around the cabinet.

LK Frame/Hatch UFH UTV

Used for LK Manifold Cabinet UFH and LK Shunt Cabinet VS2 as these cabinets are mounted externally on the wall. The frame/hatch ends flush with the outside of the cabinet.

LK Base UFH

Complement LK Frame/Hatch UFH which hides the pipe installation between cabinet and floor. Note that the LK Base can be adjusted in height between 231-291 mm.

LK Wet zone hatch PRESEAL

In rooms with a waterproofing layer on the wall, LK Manifold Cabinet UFH should be supplemented with LK Wet zone hatch PRESEAL which is connected to the waterproofing layer of the wall. The service opening (wet zone hatch) must not be placed near the bath or shower.

INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS



NOTE!

Service openings must not be fitted in bathrooms or shower areas.

Installation in stud walls

- A stud-frame thickness of at least 95 mm is required for in-wall installations.
- When installing in rooms with wall sealing layers, the LK Wet zone hatch PRESEAL requires an installation depth of at least 75 mm measured from the wet room sheet to the front edge of the shunt cabinet. For more information, see separate product range and assembly instruction sheets for LK Wet zone hatch PRESEAL.
- Pay extra attention to how deep the cabinet is fitted in relation to any insulated feed pipes.
 Refer to the illustration given in *Working* procedure Step - D.

Installation height


The design of the installation must enable perpendicular pipe penetration in relation to the cabinet bottom. The cabinet should be mounted at least 250 mm above the floor so that the drainage pipe can be laid with a drop along its entire length. To facilitate perpendicular fixing, LK Fixing Plate PIP 25 can be mounted 50-150 mm below the cabinet.



Example picture of mounting the cabinet with a distance of 250 mm from the floor surface.





WORKING PROCEDURE

The cabinet is assembled in accordance with the instructions, with the exception of the assembly of the LK Manifold Shunt VS2, which is already assembled on delivery.

Step A - Prepare pipe grommets



NOTE!

If the seal for the pipe dimension is damaged when cutting, then it must be replaced with a

Prepare pipe grommets for feed pipes and underfloor heating pipes.

 Adapt/cut the grommets to the correct dimension based on the pipe dimension use.

A cross-section of the pipe grommet shows the place ment of the pipe seal.







Step B - Knock-out

- 1. Remove the required number of knock-out holes for cables to room control.
- 2. Install the cable grommets.
- 3. If the feed pipes are to be connected from the side, the knock-out holes are removed from the side of the cabinet.
- 4. The pipe grommets are then installed for the feed pipes.



Remove the knock-out holes using a hammer and screwdriver.

Step C - Assemble the pipe grommets and sealing plugs



NOTE!

Pay particular attention during the assembly of pipe grommets and sealing plugs so the cabinet base is sealed.

- 1. Fit the adapted pipe grommets and the LK Sealing Plug before the cabinet is installed in its final location.
- 2. LK Sealing Plugs are fitted so the LK Logo can be seen inside the cabinet.

Step D - Install the cabinet

The back of the cabinet is equipped with four pre-assembled M8 nuts that can be used for attachment to the LK Cabinet stand when you wish to assemble the cabinet before a concrete slab is cast.



NOTE!


The cabinet should never be installed further out than edge to edge with the stud-frame, so the Frame/hatch GV INB can be installed.



NOTE!

If the cabinet is placed on an outer wall, it should be installed on the warm side of the construction, inside the airtight foil.

- Install the cabinet in the stud-frame externally on an existing wall.
 See heading *Installation requirements*, for information on wall rule thickness.
- 2. The design of the installation must enable perpendicular pipe penetration in relation to the cabinet bottom. The cabinet should be mounted at least 250 mm above the floor so that the drainage pipe can be laid with a drop along its entire length.
- 3. Fix the manifold cabinet to the building frame through the holes in the sides or back. For wooden rule construction, use the attached screw and sealing washer.
- 4. When the attachment is complete, seal unused holes in the cabinet. Alternatively, the cabinet can be fixed with LK Legs for Manifold Cabinet UNI/GV or LK Flexistand. See under Assembly aids.
- 5. Pay attention to the depth of the cabinet's placement so there is also space for any pipe insulation, see the example illustration.

Step E - Assemble the manifold & manifold shunt



NOTE!

When assembling a prefabricated cabinet the LK Manifold VS2 is already mounted. **LK Manifold RF is not mounted.**

- 1. Assemble the bracket attachments on the cabinet's rail. Refer to the picture below, *Assembling the LK Manifold RF.*
- 2. LK Manifold RF is then mounted on the bracket attachments.
- 3. Follow the included instructions for installation of the manifold/s.
- 4. Execute a *pressure and tightness check* of the pipe connections according to the assembly instructions.

- 5. Install the shunt bracket at the assigned place in the cabinet if it is not already mounted.
- 6. Then install the shunt group in the bracket.
- 7. Push the manifold to the shunt group and tighten the unit.

Step F - Pipe grommets

- 1. Pull the underfloor heating pipes through the pipe grommets. This is easier if the pipes have been lubricated with soapy water or similar.
- 2. The pipes are then connected to the manifold in accordance with the instructions for the manifold.



NOTE!

Check that the pipe penetration is correct fitted after all pipes have been fitted as per Step F.

- 3. Tighten connections on distributors in LK Prefab cabinets.
- 4. Check that the O-ring in the cabinet feedthrough, if present, is in a valley on the corrugated empty pipe.
- 5. Therefore, fix the empty pipes with LK Fixing plate or in another way for a perpendicular rise. It is important that the pipes enter the cabinet perpendicularly to ensure a tight bottom.

Pressure and tightness check

Pressure and tightness control must be carried out according to "Installation instructions for LK PE-X, PAL and PE-RT pipes" or according to industry regulations "Safe water installation".

Step G - Installing the cabinet drainage



NOTE!

Drainage outlets from cabinets with a tap water installation must always open into a space with a floor drain or a waterproof floor.



NOTE, EXCEPTION!

Cabinets placed in stairwells may have leakage indicators that open into the stairwell on a waterproof or water-repellent floor. The exception does not apply to detached houses.

- Drain outlet from cabinet with installation for heating systems can flow out from the wall surface under the cabinet in rooms where you normally stay and any leakage can be easily detected.
- For pipe penetrations in the wall, get measurements between pipe and adjacent wall or the floor's waterproofing layer must not be less than 60 mm.
- A leak indicator must not be placed in a bath or shower area.

Install the drainage elbow

The drainage bend can be mounted in different ways:


- Drainage elbow connected directly to the cabinet's outlet pipe.
- Drainage elbow connected via a conduit.
- Connection of drainage pipes

See page 7-8 for the different assemblies.

Drainage elbow connected directly to the cabinet's outlet pipe

Drainage from the wall surface under the cabinet. For cabinets mounted externally on the wall, the drainage elbow opens out into the pre-drilled hole in the base.

- 1. Connect the drainage elbow directly to the cabinet's outlet pipe after all pipe inlets and sealing plugs have been installed.
- 2. Fix the drainage elbow to a wall stud in a suitable position. Insert the two installation screws supplied in any of the fixing holes.






Principle picture. Drainage elbow directly connected to the cabinet's outlet opens in the same room as the cabinet's service opening.

- 1. Connect the conduit to the cabinet's drainage pipe using the bellow sleeve. The bellow sleeve must not be deformed in a manner that prevents the flow of any water leaks.
- 2. Connect the drainage elbow to the conduit. Note that the pipe should rest in the drainage elbow at a depth of approximately 20 mm.
- 3. Fix the drainage elbow to a wall stud in a suitable position. Insert the two installation screws supplied in any of the fixing holes.
- 4. Ensure that the conduit is installed sloping downwards towards the outlet and that the conduit is secured.

Connection of drainage pipes

It is possible to connect drainage pipes from two cabinets. The illustration below shows side-by-side installation but drainage pipes can also be connected when the cabinets are mounted further apart.

- 1. Use LK Drainage Kit 25 Duo.
- 2. Fix the drainage elbow to a wall stud in a suitable position. Insert the two installation screws supplied in any of the fixing holes.
- 3. Ensure that the conduit is installed sloping downwards towards the outlet and that the conduit is secured.

Installation of outlet plate

NOTE!



Although LK Systems can supply the LK Pipe Membrane, the sealing contractor should carry out the installation and be responsible for the waterproofing characteristics of the sealing layer in accordance with industry regulations issued by the Swedish Ceramic Tile Council (BBV), Swedish Flooring Trade Association Wet Room Control (GVK) or the Swedish Painting Industry Wet Room Control (MVK).

- Install a wall panel with a hole for the drainage elbow's outlet pipe. Hole diameter approx.
 26 mm. Connect any sealing layer as per the instructions of the supplier of the sealing layer.
- 2. Once the wall panelling is installed, the drainage elbow should be cut to size using the LK Drainage elbow cutter V2. Alternatively, the drainage elbow can be cut to a suitable length using a tool such as a hack-saw blade.
- 3. Be careful not to damage the surface layer, leave 2-3 mm of the outlet pipe protruding from the wall. In rooms with a waterproof layer on the wall leave 6-9 mm.
- 4. Install the LK Outlet Plate V2 in the outlet pipe. For a more luxurious finish, the LK Outlet Plate V2 Chrome is available as an accessory.

Step H - Install Spray Guard

 Assemble the spray guard supplied. Be careful that the guard is pushed out to the side so the entire cabinet width is covered by the guard.

Step I - Install Frame/hatch

There are two types of frames/hatches depending on whether the cabinet is mounted inside or outside on an interior wall. In rooms with a waterproofing layer on the wall, the LK Manifold Cabinet must be supplemented with the LK Wet Zone Hatch PRESEAL, which is connected to the wall's waterproofing layer.

Service opening (wet zone hatch) must not be placed in place of bath or shower. For more information on the product range and installation instructions for the LK Wet Zone Hatch PRESEAL, see www.lksystems.se/en.

Install Frame/hatch UFH INB

When the cabinet is built into a wall, the LK Frame/hatch UFH INB is used which has a precipitating frame in order to cover the hole around the cabinet. The frame covers an area of 15 mm beyond the edge of the cabinet.

• Install the LK Frame/hatch using the M5 screws provided. If the cabinet is installed so far into the construction that the screws are too short, then these should be replaced with longer screws (not included).

Install Frame/hatch UFH UTV

When the cabinet is installed externally on a wall, the LK Frame/hatch UFH UTV is used, which fits edge to edge with the outsides of the cabinet.


• Install the frame using the screws and mounting plates (4 pcs) provided, see the illustration. Fit the four white cover plugs on the end of the cabinet.

Install Base

- 1. With an external installation of the LK Shunt Cabinet VS2, install the LK Base by first pushing the upper part of the base into the intended grooves in the cabinet frame.
- 2. Also ensure that the drainage elbow runs through the intended hole.
- 3. The lower part of the base is then pulled out to the floor.
- 4. When the correct height is reached, then the installation is fixed using screws on the front of the base.
- 5. Adapt the length of the drainage elbow to the outside of the base and install the outlet plate.

Installation of LK Shunt Cabinet VS2 Prefab

The cabinet is installed in accordance with the instructions above with the exception of the installation of the LK Manifold RF and the LK Manifold Shunt VS2, which are already assembled on delivery.



ASSEMBLY AIDS

Assembly is easier with the LK Cabinet Stand L2

The back of the cabinet is fitted with four anchor points (M8 nuts) which can be used to assemble the cabinet before the concrete base is cast. The LK Cabinet Stand L2 can be used as an aid and is assembled as below.



LK Cabinet Stand L2 with anchor clips.

- 1. Mount the four M8 nuts provided in the back of the cabinet.
- 2. Attach pipe fixings to the extended bolts.
- 3. Slip on the round bar and attach the conduit pieces provided with the stand. The conduits stop the stand from becoming set in the concrete, making it reusable.
- 4. Knock down the round bars through the insulation and into the sand until the installation feels stable.
- 5. Lift up the cabinet to a suitable height and tighten the fixings.
- 6. Tape the conduits to the legs of the stand to stop the conduits from moving when pouring the concrete.

Assembly with the LK Legs for Manifold Cabinet UNI/GV

The LK Legs for Manifold Cabinet UNI/GV simplifies cabinet assembly on prefabricated concrete joists. Manufactured from galvanised steel plate.

Supplied in pairs with 4 self-tapping screws to fix to the manifold cabinet. The feet have 6 mm holes for fixing to the concrete floor structure. The legs are secured using a bolt or metal nail plug (not supplied).






LK Legs for Manifold Cabinet UNI/GV.







